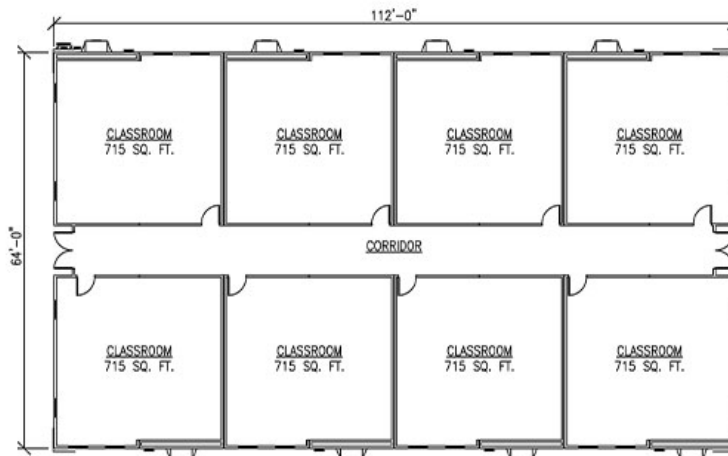

## Modular Education Buildings in Action: Moore County Schools

### The Problem

- ↳ Pinehurst Elementary, part of Moore County Schools, was originally built in the 1940s and needed some serious renovations to its facilities. The current institution couldn't keep up with the growing enrollment and student population.

### The Key Decision Factors

- ↳ Moore County Schools knew that these renovations would take up to a year and a half, and needed a space to hold all elementary classes and management offices. With limited timelines, they needed a solution that would be up and running before the beginning of the school year.

### The Modular Solution

- ↳ Using an open park field, BOXX Modular constructed 8 separate modules which encompassed 8,000 square feet. The entire complex was leased to them so everything was returned to BOXX Modular once the permanent structure was ready for use.



The campus included 50,000 square feet of classroom space, offices, a library, restrooms, and more. The entirety of this project was completed and installed in less than 3 months.
